

Colour Print Classic Instructions Digital Printable Garment Vinyl



General

Colour Print Classic is designed for use on:

- 100% Cotton
- 100% Polyester
- Poly/cotton blends
- Cotton Caps.

Please Note:

You will also require Stahls Colour Print Mask to transfer the printed Colour Print Classic onto your garments.

Colour Print Classic is designed for contour cutting of images and limited cutting detail. Detailed parts of your design should be printed, not cut.

Preparation

Colour Print Classic is designed for use with the following types of printers:

- Thermo Resin
- Inkjet Solvent
- Eco Solvent

As with any digital media it is essential that it is not exposed to grease and oils. Any traces of these, eg fingerprints will have a detrimental effect on the printed area including patches / blotches in the print.

If the media is exposed to grease or oils you can clean the surface with isopropyl alcohol, then allow to dry.

To prevent grease residue always handle the Colour Print Classic by the edges only.

Printing And Application

- **1.** Leave material in a room temperature of 20°C or higher.
- 2. Feed material into your printer so that the media faces up and the carrier is on the bottom.
- **3.** Print the image. Contour cut the image. We recommend you allow the material to dry for at least 12 hours before heat transferring the design.
- **4.** Weed away the excess material leaving only the printed image.
- **5.** Pre-heat the garment for tens seconds in order to remove any moisture or wrinkles.
- **6.** If your design is particularly small use Stahls Colour Print Mask to transfer design from backing sheet onto garment
- 7. Position the design on the garment, with the Stahls Colour Print Mask on the top.
- **8.** If you are not using Stahls Colour Print Mask cover the design with a piece of release paper in order to protect the material from the heat press platen
- 9. Use the following settings for pressing your design

Temperature: 150°C

Time: 10-15 seconds
Pressure: Light/Medium

10. If using Stahls Colour Print Mask wait until cold before peeling. If not using Stahls Colour Print Mask peel release paper back immediately after pressing.

Washing Instructions

Machine-wash inside out at 40°C using a mild detergent.

Do not bleach

Iron in reverse

Do not iron on to Colour Print Classic
